Rules And Conditions

1. This is a JTE/B.T.B.A. tour event and will be sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. their rules will govern the event along with the following special rules and conditions. BTBA cards must be shown at registration or a fine of £2.00 will be levied
2. This will be a scratch doubles tournament throughout with teams being split into four average groups: Section 1 Combined average of 351 and above, Section 2. Combined average of 291 to 350, Section 3. Combined average 246 to 290. Section 4 245 and below. Each team will bowl eight games changing lanes after . every two games.
- 3 Entrants must declare their highest average in any league, tournament or merit table over 21 gms on the day bowling. Y.B.C. officials must submit a current league standing sheet ***seven days prior to bowling***.
- 4 The tournament manager, Brian Parker, reserves the right to refuse or rerate any entry if he considers there is just cause to do so. Protests must be lodged by the Y.B.C. official / bowler within 30mins and confirmed in writing within 72hrs or before the presentation. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. The tournament managers decision is final subject to appeal to to the B.T.B.A.
- 5 No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcohol anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification of the individual concerned. Profane Language, improper gestures or abuse of bowling equipment / machinery may also result in disqualification Any disqualification may result in loss of scores / awards. Any bowler whose conduct is likely to bring the sport into disrepute will also be disqualified. Any individual disqualified will be reported to the B.T.B.A. for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
- 6 Competitors who are not dressed in correct bowling attire in the bowlers area will not be permitted to bowl Shirts must contain YBC / Bowlers name. Mobile phones should be turned off and not taken into bowling area
- 7 Only tournament officials, Players and one ***Licensed*** instructor / coach per team will be allowed in the playing area. YBC officials, instructors and coaches must adhere to the dress code laid down in the tournament rules. Pacers must have already bowled in the tournament.
- 8 Closing date for entries will be Friday 30/03/2018
- 9 ***Entry Fees must be paid in full by the closing date. No entry fees will be refunded after squadding Except in the case of cancellation of the tournament.***
